

REACH Regulation

As a distributor and/or importer of articles, we take our obligations under the REACH Regulation (EC 1907/2006) very seriously.

According to the definition in Article 3 point 3 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH), our products are articles because the specific form or shape determines the function to a greater extent than the chemical composition.

Any lubricants or preservatives are considered an integral part of the article.

Articles as such are not subject to registration under REACH, but there is a notification obligation for substances of very high concern in articles if they are present in the article at a certain concentration

If Protempo uses a substance that is subject to disclosure due to changes in our knowledge, we will list it here.

Notifiable substances:

In seals of ball bearings with plastic seals as plasticizer:

- Bis-(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) > 0.1%.
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) > 0.1%.
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) > 0.1%.
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) > 0.1%.

In gas springs as an alloying element:

- Lead (Pb) > 0.1%.
